- 1. The meeting was opened at 6.35pm and J. Hughes welcomed all and the new members were introduced.
- 2. The minutes of the last meeting held on 3rd August 2016 were accepted as a true and accurate record of what took place. Prop. M. Rees. 2nd J. Fowler.
- 3. The CQC inspection results rated the Practice as GOOD. The full CQC report is available on the web site. The PPG congratulated the practice on achieving this high standard.
- 4. The Birmingham Cross City Partnership (CCG) is instigating a Medicine Management Campaign involving prescription monitoring to reduce medicine waste from repeat prescriptions.
- 5. The Practice doctors are now carrying out their own Patient Satisfaction Surveys.
- 6. ACE Foundation is to now carry out assessment of the risk of falls in patients over 75 years of age.
- 7. Recruitment of PPG members is ongoing and will also be aimed at attracting younger members. The PPG campaign will continue with the Vaccinations for Flu, Shingles and Pneumonia. Breast Cancer screening and Age Related Health Checks are to be included again.
- 8. Pneumococcal Vaccination program is still on going. Flu Vaccination has been carried out on 55% of eligible patients to date and is progressing. Shingles Vaccine take up has been reduced compared with previous years at 73.1% (155 patients).
- 9. Infection Prevention is continually monitored within the Practice.
- 10. The meeting was closed at 7.35 pm. The next meeting will be held on Wednesday 1st February 2017 at 6.30 pm at College Road Surgery.
