

Minutes of College Road Surgery PPG Meeting held 14th June 2022.

- The meeting was opened at 6.30 pm and J. Hughes welcomed all.
- The minutes of the last meeting held on 14th June 2022 were accepted as a true and accurate record of what there and then took place. Proposed G. Cox. Seconded J. Allen.
- R.S. reiterated the PPG Code. Primary Care Network and “Signposting” were discussed. Photographic recognition for staff is to be introduced. Staff will include a Paramedic and a Physiotherapist. Drs Silvetti and Mula are specializing in Women’s Health including menopause issues.
- The difficulty in obtaining doctor appointments was again discussed. Dr Sarin explained the increased number of patients registered with the practice and the social deprivation of a large proportion of new registrations was causing difficulties. The problems with repeat prescriptions not recognising 30 and 31 day months was high lighted. Prescriptions need to be adjusted to allow for this.
- The Covid 19 vaccination Clinics are being carried out on Saturdays and Saturday GP appointments are available at the Oaks. Flu Vaccination uptake in the over 65 age group has achieved 81%.
- The PPG Message of the month is to be “Women’s Health” with Drs Silvetti and Mula leading.
